5. BUDGET DESCRIPTION: Maximum award is \$25,000. Provide a brief narrative/outline of the proposed cost categories (personnel, supplies, travel, and other) with a brief justification. Equipment requests are not encouraged but are allowed, if sufficient justification is provided. Equipment costs, if included, may not exceed 10% of the total award of \$25,000. Indirect costs are not encouraged, but are allowed up to 10%. Salary support for the mentor is not allowed.
6. TWO LETTERS OF SUPPORT: a) one from the mentor for the project to include a brief description of the mentor's involvement and mentoring plan, b) description of commitment from the applicant's facility to support the project in a successful manner.
